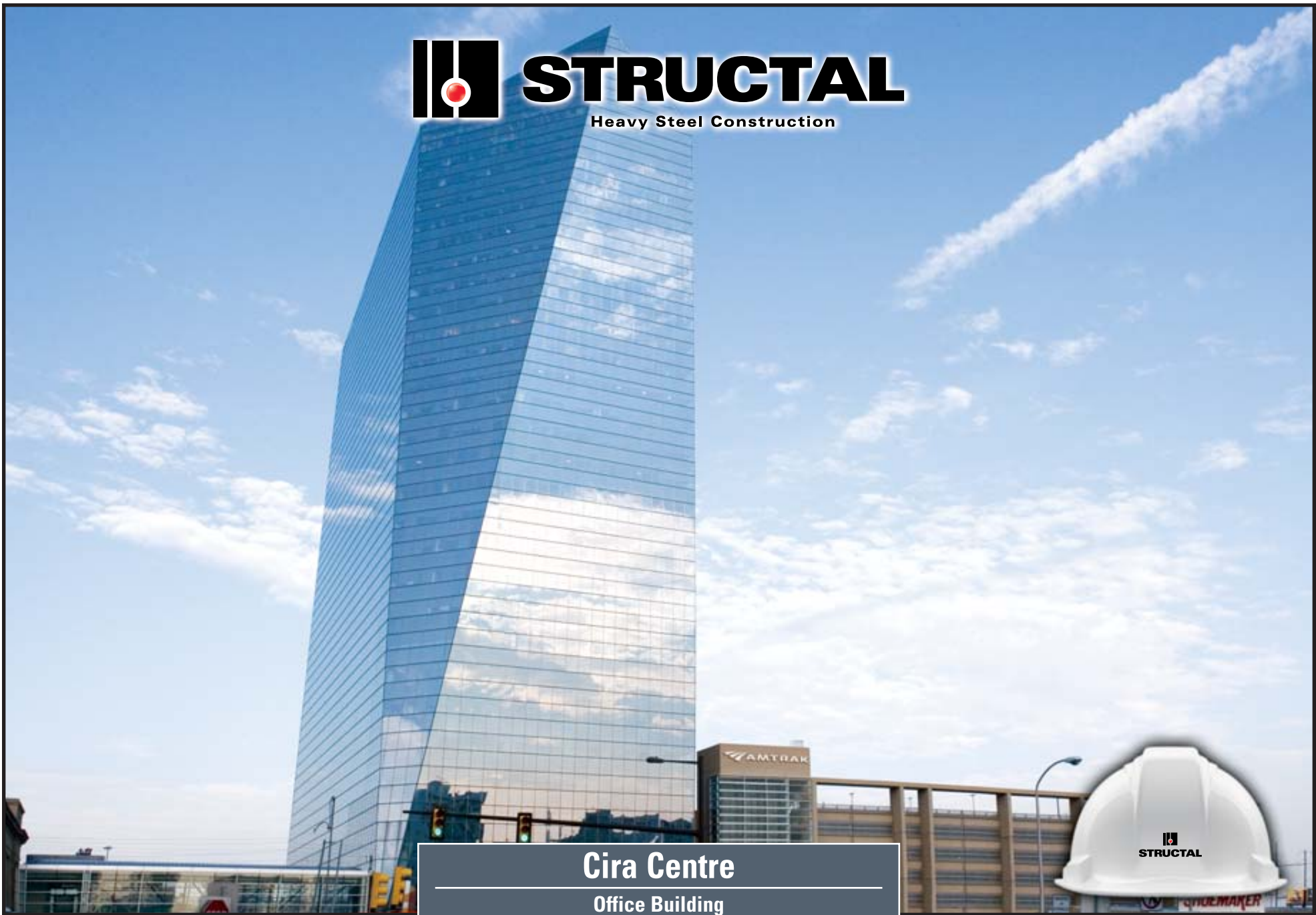

Highlights

The Cira Centre is a 29-story steel office building that is clad in reflective glass.

The 784,000 square feet (72,836 square meter) building is the tallest building in Philadelphia, PA outside of Center City, and is part of the city's Keystone Opportunity Zone revitalization project.

A skyway connects the building to a parking garage to the north of Cira Centre and with 30th Street Station to the south.



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
